Noni was born in Springs East-Rand to a family of singers and grew up in Mpumalanga, South Africa, where she launched her career at the age of 7 performing to over 400 people.

Noni performs regularly in a variety of settings, from churches to festivals. She is regularly featured as a soloist with the South African Gospel Choir, and has worked as a soloist and session musician for artists such as Osibisa and Alex Wilson.

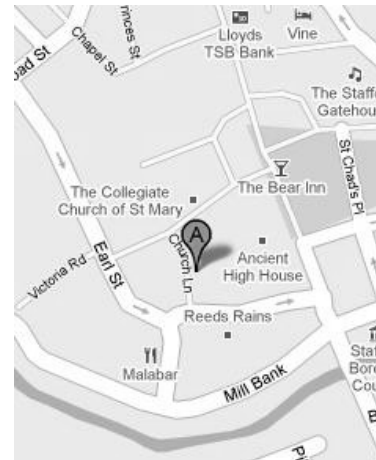
The workshop
